## **DONATION GUIDELINES**

## **WE ACCEPT:**

- **Kitchen Utensils**: spatulas, large spoons, tongs, pizza cutters, hand graters, measuring cups/spoons, mixing bowls, etc.
- **Small Kitchen Appliances**: hand mixers, stand mixers, microwaves, toasters, air fryers, Crock Pots, Instapots, electric skillets, blenders, food processors, etc.
- **Dishes / Serving Dishes**: plates, bowls, serving bowls, serving platters, pitchers, etc.
- **Drinkware**: cups, mugs, glasses, martini glasses, wine glasses, etc.
- Flatware: silverware, serving utensils, etc.
- Storage containers: all shapes and sizes and types. MUST HAVE THEIR LIDS!
- **Pots/Pans**: pots of all sizes and types, frying pans of all sizes and types, etc.
- **Kitchen Gadgets:** food choppers, egg slicers, timers, food thermometers, etc.
- **Misc. Kitchen Items:** canisters, cutting boards & mats, butter dishes, etc.
- **Housewares:** kitchen towels, placemats, cloth napkins, kitchen-themed décor, folding chairs, folding lawn chairs, irons, ironing boards, rolling carts, humidifiers, de-humidifiers, etc.

## WE CANNOT ACCEPT

- Kitchen or dining room furniture
- Large kitchen appliances (refrigerators, freezers, stoves, etc.)
- Anything in need of repair
- Anything that does not work
- Anything that stinks/smells, is moldy or dirty
- Anything too heavy for one person to carry or doesn't fit into a vehicle for transport
